Optional guided tour at **Palazzo Colonna** (Piazza dei Santi Apostoli, 66)

Palazzo Colonna is one of the oldest and largest private palaces of Rome. Its construction began in the fourteenth century by the Colonna family. The construction of the various wings of the Palace lasted for five centuries. This has led to the overlapping of different architectural styles which characterize and reflect the different periods.

Optional guided tour at **Galleria Borghese** (Piazzale Scipione Borghese, 5)

The Galleria Borghese is an art gallery in Rome, housed in the former Villa Borghese Pinciana. The Galleria Borghese houses a substantial part of the Borghese Collection of paintings, sculpture and antiquities, begun by Cardinal Scipione Borghese, the nephew of Pope Paul V (reign 1605–1621).
